where to start

choosing a builder

When you're looking for someone to build a swimming pool, it's important to meet with at least three or four builders. Look at their galleries, ask questions, and ask for referrals. Talk with individuals who have had firsthand experience with each builder. From there you can start to establish a relationship with a builder you feel you can trust.

One of the most difficult times in the decision-making process happens when builders offer conflicting information about design and technology choices. To better understand these differing perspectives, try and get a sense of the builder's or salesperson's background with the company. How much experience do they have in the industry? How long have they been working at their current company? How long has the company been in business? How old are the pools in the photos you're looking at?

Forming a trusting relationship with your builder will allow you to arrive at the right design together and will help you to feel more comfortable during the construction process.




what we do

our approach to pricing

Deciding on a budget may be confusing for first time pool buyers, as pricing varies widely across the industry. Our pools typically cost between \$80,000 and \$200,000, with an average price of \$125,000. We understand that not everyone has an unlimited budget for their project, so we're interested in helping you create the right pool for your budget range.

Why do our swimming pools sometimes cost more than other builders?

We view our pools as an investment in your home, and it shows in our workmanship. Our swimming pools are built to the highest standard, and we pride ourselves on the thoughtfulness and elegance of our designs. We don't cut corners. In order to achieve a beautiful design, a few more features may be required like a retaining wall or a more ergonomic walkway. It is important to us that we not sacrifice the integrity of the structure and how it operates, but we can also save you money down the road by avoiding structural problems and ensuring proper supervision during construction. In addition, we always use the best subcontractors we can find who use a higher grade of material and who take the time to get their work right.

Some other companies claim they can build a similar pool for less, but how are they achieving cheaper prices? Some companies are able to offer a less expensive option because they are operating on volume. That means you might have a construction manager who is juggling 60 projects at one time, and you may not get the personalized attention you are looking for. Other companies may sacrifice on design or quality to achieve a lower price.

We take a lot of care to ensure that our pools are budgeted properly and priced fairly for our customers, and our proposal will include a pricing breakdown to help you understand the costs.





your free consultation

setting up for success

When you meet with John for your free consultation, it's important to establish a few facts and figures to get the best design for your dream swimming pool.

- What are your must-haves?
- What are your would-like-to-haves?
- What are your hopes and expectations for the budget, and what amount is too much to spend?
- How do you envision using your pool?
- What are your aesthetic tastes?

The most important aspect of this initial meeting is that all decision makers discuss their desires as fully as possible. John will look at your yard and home and get a sense of the space and aesthetic environment. He'll talk with you about your wish list and how your pool can function in harmony with your lifestyle. **Be open to recommendations from your expert.**Sometimes just a few tweaks can give you all of the functionality you desire within your budget range.

next steps

Once John has a good sense of what you're looking for in a swimming pool, you'll be asked to sign a non disclosure agreement, or NDA. Our designs are one-of-a-kind and thoughtfully created just for you, and a lot of effort goes into perfecting each detail. The NDA is required and necessary to protect us from other builders using our ideas, while you're still deciding who to choose. We appreciate your cooperation!

a beautiful design for you

After a few sketches and additional conversation as needed, John will create a beautiful 3-D rendering of your pool in our state-of-the-art Pool Studio software. This rendering can show your pool within the setting of your own yard—furnishings and all—giving you a sense of precisely what it will look like. We can even show you how it will look at any time of day or night with all of the lights and features.

At a second meeting, you'll review this rendering and discuss a budget range depending on different features and material choices. Look over the design carefully, and let us know what you think. We understand the design sometimes isn't perfect on the first try, so this meeting's purpose is to thoroughly discuss all of your options.





moving forward

arriving at the perfect design

At this point we have a preliminary idea with ballpark pricing. If you like where our ideas are headed, and you'd like to work toward exacting your design with One Thousand Waves, we'll request a \$2,000 partial payment toward your initial contract deposit. This earnest money tells us that you're serious about moving forward with One Thousand Waves and gives us the green light to proceed with at least 30 hours of refining and rendering, plus a detailed cost analysis of your project. Later, if you're not happy and decide not to sign a contract with us, we'll refund \$1,000 back to you and keep \$1,000 for the work we've done so far.


signing your contract

Congratulations! You're on your way to the outdoor living space of your dreams. Once John has worked with you to arrive at the design and price you're looking for, it's time to sign your contract and complete the initial deposit.

What if construction begins, and I decide that I want to make changes?

Changes in the middle of construction can be quite costly, so it is important that you take the time you need with John before signing your contract to fully execute the swimming pool design. Once construction begins, your pool will be built exactly as specified in your contract. The great thing about our turnkey contracts is that we will build your pool at the contract price, even if it ends up costing us more than we anticipated.

If you do decide you'd like to change something about your pool after signing the contract, don't worry. Change orders will include a signed addendum with an adjusted contract price for materials and labor, but we will not charge a change order fee the first time. Any design adjustments after the first change order may be subject to a change order fee at John's discretion depending on the scale of the changes.

phases of construction

After the contract signing and initial deposit, our pools are built in several phases which typically include:

- excavation
- steel
- plumbing
- gunite
- masonry
- decking
- equipment
- interior finish
- final details

We do our best to thoroughly explain each phase prior to its initiation and address any concerns you may have. Let us know what is important to you throughout this process. Do you have outdoor pets? What about your family and neighbors? Building a pool can be a major disruption to your life and your home, and our goal is to minimize the effects. We strive to provide a concierge service with care that is personal for you, your family, your space, and your neighbors.

turnkey contract structure



startup and pool school

Once your pool is finished, we'll send over a qualified service technician to start up the pool, which includes turning on pumps, brushing the pool regularly, and monitoring the chemistry. Throughout the next 30 days, we will continue these services, ensuring everything is working as expected. Your technician will also install hardware and plumbing fixtures and program the computers.

Next, your tech will schedule your pool school, which will take about an hour and a half. In this session, they will explain every aspect of the pool chemistry, maintenance, and how to operate your pool. Pool school can be overwhelming, so we recommend recording a video to refer back to later.

You've probably heard salespeople say that your pool can take care of itself, but pools require regular maintenance. Taking care of your pool is like housekeeping and needs to be done every week, but advancements have come a long way, and we're striving to make it easier than ever. paramount in-floor cleaning system

Experience the freedom of a self-cleaning pool with the Paramount PV3 automatic in-floor pool cleaning and circulation system. Built directly into the pool floor and made to last for the life of your pool, PV3 is engineered to clean your entire pool including walls, floors, steps, benches, and even spas. The rotating cleaning nozzles work together to systematically sweep debris out of your pool through the main drain and skimmers. After about an hour, nearly every square inch of your pool will have been swept one time. When not operating, PV3 nozzles retract flush with the pool floor, becoming virtually invisible. There are no vacuum hoses left floating in the pool; all that's left is a sparkling clean pool that's ready to enjoy.








An Advanced Cleaning and Circulation System
